

## *Prayer Shawl Knitting Ministry*

Gold Hill's Prayer Shawl Knitters provide special shawls to people who are ill, hurting in some way, or just needing the feel of God's loving arms around them. The shawls are knit or crocheted by ladies who work their needles while praying for God's love to enfold and bless the recipient of each shawl. Although much needlework is done in homes, in cars, on planes, trains and buses, we do meet at **10 a.m. on the 3rd Thursday of each month at Big Sky Senior Living Center's library.** The shawls, when finished, are blessed by the Gold Hill Knitters, sewn with a label, then made available for give-away.

There is a sheet hanging on the side of the yarn cupboard in the fireside room for those giving a shawl to sign. We have yarn and needles to share. Any interested people are welcomed to join Gold Hill's ministry of knitting/crocheting. The group also knits scarves for the homeless, which are then placed in various locations uptown for those who need some added warmth.
